

■ ApplePly Project Checklist

Plan, Prep & Build with Confidence

■ Project Planning

- Choose a project (cabinet, shelf, furniture, etc.)
- Sketch or download project plans
- Determine finished dimensions
- Calculate total ApplePly sheets needed (include 10–15% extra)
- Confirm thickness: ■ 1/4" ■ 1/2" ■ 3/4" ■ Other: _____
- Plan for grain direction and exposed edges
- Set a realistic timeline and budget

■ Materials & Tools

- ApplePly sheets (qty: _____)
- Edge banding (if not showing ply layers)
- Wood glue (recommend: Titebond III)
- Screws or fasteners (type: _____)
- Wood filler or putty
- Primer & paint or stain & sealer
- Sandpaper (80, 120, 220 grits)
- Tools:
 - ■ Table saw ■ Router ■ Drill/driver ■ Clamps ■ Measuring tape & square ■ Orbital sander

■■ Cutting & Assembly

- Mark cuts carefully with grain in mind
- Cut panels to size with clean blade
- Dry-fit pieces before gluing
- Apply wood glue to joints
- Clamp and allow to dry fully
- Sand all surfaces and edges smooth

■ Finishing Touches

- Fill holes and sand smooth
- Clean surface of dust
- Apply finish:
 - ■ Clear coat (for exposed edges) ■ Stain (test on scrap first) ■ Paint (use wood primer first)
- Let dry and cure fully before use

■ Bonus Tips

- Test cuts on scrap ApplePly
- Keep exposed edges visible—they look great!
- Store leftover pieces flat to prevent warping
