Outdoor Waterproofing Checklist

Prep:	
	[] Choose your waterproofing method (sealer, paint, or epoxy)
	[] Check weather forecast (dry weather for 24-48 hrs)
	[] Gather supplies
	[] Place drop cloth or cardboard
	[] Wear gloves and a mask if needed
Surface Prep:	
	[] Lightly sand all plywood surfaces (100-150 grit)
	[] Wipe off dust with tack cloth or damp rag
	[] Fill any holes or cracks with wood filler (optional)
	[] Let filler dry and sand smooth
Waterproofing:	
	[] Apply first coat of chosen waterproofing product
	[] Seal all edges and corners carefully
	[] Let dry fully (check product label for timing)
	[] Lightly sand between coats (optional but recommended)
	[] Apply second coat (or more, if needed)
	[] Let final coat cure completely
Aftercare:	
	[] Store leftover product safely
	[] Clean brushes or rollers
	[] Check project every 6-12 months for reapplication
