How to Safely Remove a Wall - Printable Checklist

- 1. Determine if the wall is load-bearing.
- 2. Obtain necessary permits or approvals (if required).
- 3. Turn off power to any electrical outlets or switches in the wall.
- 4. Shut off plumbing lines connected to the wall (if any).
- 5. Remove trim, baseboards, and any attached fixtures.
- 6. Cut and remove drywall carefully to expose studs and wiring.
- 7. Cap electrical wires or reroute with professional help.
- 8. Install temporary support walls if the wall is load-bearing.
- 9. Remove wall studs and framing elements.
- 10. Patch flooring, ceiling, and walls as needed.
- 11. Dispose of debris safely and legally.
- 12. Call in professionals for structural or electrical work if unsure.
- 13. Inspect the work and finish with paint, trim, or flooring repairs.
