

DIY Farmhouse Bench Building Plans

Build your own farmhouse bench with these simple, beginner-friendly plans. Includes measurements, cut list, and step-by-step assembly instructions.

Bench Measurements:

| Part | Quantity | Dimensions |
|---------------------------|----------|------------------|
| Seat | 1 | 48" L x 10-12" W |
| Legs | 4 | 17-18" H (2x4) |
| Long Stretcher | 1 | 40" L (2x4) |
| Optional Center Stretcher | 1 | 40" L (2x4) |

Step-by-Step Assembly Instructions:

Step 1: Measure and cut all lumber pieces according to the measurements above.

Step 2: Assemble each leg into an 'H' shape using two vertical 2x4s and one horizontal 2x4.

Step 3: Connect the two legs with the long stretcher. Use screws and wood glue for strength.

Step 4: Flip the seat board upside down, center the leg assembly on top, and attach with 2.5" screws.

Step 5: Sand all surfaces smooth, starting with 80-grit and finishing with 220-grit. Round the edges slightly.

Step 6: Finish with stain, paint, or a protective topcoat depending on your style.

Tip: For outdoor benches, use exterior-rated screws, waterproof wood glue, and a weather-resistant finish for durability.
